

**MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL
CITY OF SARGENT, NEBRASKA
Special Session
Sargent Community Center
July 20, 2015**

The Mayor and Council of the City of Sargent, Nebraska, met in Special Session at the Sargent Community Center on the 20th day of July, 2015, at 7:00 p.m. Notice of the meeting was posted at the City Office, U.
