

**Minutes Of City Council  
City Of Sargent, Nebraska  
Town Hall Meeting  
Sargent Community Center  
February 19, 2019**

The Mayor and Council of the City of Sargent, Nebraska, met for a Town Hall Meeting at the Sargent Community Center on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of February 2019, at 7:00 p.m. Notice of the meeting was posted at the City Office, U. S. Post Office, Sargent Corner Market and First National Bank on Thursday February 14, 2019. The following were present: Council Members: Ricky Hightower, Gerry Sheets and Mayor Kozeal, City Administrator/Utility Superintendent Reece Jensen, and City Clerk/Treasurer Gwenda Horky.

Mayor Kozeal publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy posted on the east wall of the meeting room in the Sargent Community Center. Mayor Kozeal called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

Reece Jensen explained to the public that on February 12, 2019 the City took a water sample, and it came back positive for coliform. Therefore the City decided to chlorinate the water.

Mr. Jensen stressed the importance of using a backflow preventer on heat pumps and that every backflow preventer needs to be inspected yearly. Mr. Jensen informed the public about a backflow preventer that goes on a hydrant.

Several questions were asked by the public.

Motion was made by Council Member Sheets and seconded by Council Member Hightower to adjourn the meeting. Voting yea: Hightower, Sheets, and Kozeal. Voting nay: None. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:42 P.M.
